Commissioners:

Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C. (“CIG”) is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (“Commission”) in Docket No. CP25-7-000, notification of abandonment of the Powder River Abandonment Project (“Project”).

### **Description of Proceeding**

On October 17, 2024, CIG filed an application pursuant to Section 7(b) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. Section 717f(b) and Sections 157.7 and 157.18 of the Commission’s regulations, for authorization to abandon, by sale to its affiliate Hiland Crude LLC, an approximate 100-mile portion of its Powder River Lateral and related appurtenances located in Albany and Converse Counties, Wyoming. On April 1, 2025, the Commission issued CIG its Order Approving Abandonment (“Order”).<sup>1</sup>

### **Affirmative Statement and Notification of Abandonment**

In compliance with ordering paragraph (C) of the Commission’s Order, CIG is herein informing the Commission that the abandonment, by sale, of its Powder River Lateral closed on March 25, 2026.

### **Filing Information**

CIG is e-Filing this notice with the Commission’s Secretary in accordance with the Commission’s Order No. 703, Filing Via the Internet, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007 in Docket No. RM07-16-000.
