Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C. ("CIG") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP19-56-000 its Weekly Environmental Inspector Report related to the CIG High Plains Kiowa Lateral Expansion Project.

Description of Proceeding

On January 24, 2019, CIG filed a prior notice request to Sections 157.205(b), 157.208(b), and 157.210 of the Commission's Regulations under the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct and operate two laterals and metering facilities located in Weld County, Colorado. The project is referred to as the "CIG High Plains Kiowa Lateral Expansion Project".

1. Summary of Construction Activity for Inspection Period:

During this reporting period, the tie-in at Highway 76 was completed and preparations were made to cross the wetlands at STA 71+42. The hydrotest was completed on the High Five Lateral and High Five Meter Station. Painting, backfilling and electrical activities occurred at the Prairie Hound Meter Station. Contractor activities were limited during the reporting period due to the July 4th holiday.

2. Relevant Environmental Activities:

During this reporting period, no one received environmental training. A total of one-hundred and fifty-seven (157) people have received training on the CIG High Plains Kiowa Lateral Expansion Project.

The contractor installed mats, sandbags, and dewatering structures in the wetlands located at STA 71+42 in preparation of open cutting for this feature. The final cleanup of the wetland located at STA 472+73 was completed. Erosion control devices were inspected after rain events.

3. Environmental Problems/Issues and Corrective Actions Taken:

There were no environmental problems or issues identified during this reporting period.

4. Environmental Compliance Issues/Resolutions:

There were no environmental compliance issues identified during this reporting period.

5. Issues and Concerns Identified by Landowners:

No landowner issues or concerns were identified during this reporting period.

6. Work Planned for the Following Reporting Period:

It is anticipated in the next reporting period that the ROW cleanup will continue on the completed portions of the Kiowa Lateral. The pipe will be installed in the wetlands located at STA 71+42. Construction and painting activities will continue at both the Prairie Hound and High Five Meter Stations.


