Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C. ("CIG") is filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP25-7-000, its electronic hydraulic flow model files used to support the flow diagrams provided as Exhibit V in the Powder River Abandonment Project application.

Description of Proceeding

On October 17, 2024, CIG submitted its abbreviated application pursuant to Section 7(b) of the Natural Gas Act, as amended, and Part 157, Subpart A of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's ("Commission") regulations, requesting approval to abandon, by sale, a portion of its Powder River Lateral system and abandon in place certain Powder River Lateral metering facilities. This proposal is referred to as the "Powder River Abandonment Project."

Filing Information

CIG submits this filing to supplement the application with the attached electronic hydraulic flow model files.

CIG states that the hydraulic flow model files contain proprietary and competitively sensitive commercial, engineering or design information that is considered a trade secret and confidential information. In accordance with the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 388.112 (2024), CIG hereby requests privileged treatment for this material and notes that the Commission routinely treats this type of information as privileged and exempt from mandatory disclosure under the Freedom of Information Act, 18 C.F.R. § 388.107(d) (2024); 5 U.S.C. § 552(b)(4). CIG has labeled this material as "Contains CUI//PRIV - Do Not Release." The privileged material is also considered CEII pursuant to the Commission's regulations 18 C.F.R. § 388.113 (2024), and has been labeled as "Contains CUI//CEII - Do Not Release".
