Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C. ("CIG") is filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP25-7-000, an update regarding its proposed Powder River Abandonment Project ("Project").

Description of Proceeding

On October 17, 2024, CIG filed an application pursuant to Section 7(b) of the Natural Gas Act, 15 U.S.C. Section 717f(b) and Sections 157.7 and 157.18 of the Commission's regulations, for authorization to abandon, by sale, an approximate 100-mile portion of its Powder River Lateral and related appurtenances located in Albany and Converse Counties, Wyoming. On April 1, 2025, the Commission issued an order approving the abandonment, subject to certain conditions.

Abandonment Update

As part of the sale of its Powder River Lateral to Hiland Crude LLC ("Hiland"), CIG noted that it would isolate and remove eight mainline valves located along the 100-mile Powder River Lateral. After additional discussions with Hiland, CIG has agreed to include the eight mainline valves as part of sale and transfer of facilities to Hiland. As a result of this updated arrangement, CIG is herein notifying the Commission that it will no longer isolate and remove the eight mainline valves and instead will convey the valves to Hiland as part of the sale. All other components of the proposed sale and

abandonment remain unchanged. CIG anticipates to complete the sale and effectuate the transfer of the Powder River Lateral by the end of the fourth quarter of 2025.²


