Commissioners:

On December 10, 1984, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") issued an Order Amending Order ("Order") in Docket No. CP79-128-005. Among other things, the Order permitted Colorado Interstate Gas Company, L.L.C. ("CIG") to convert oil wells within the Flank Storage Field to injection/withdrawal or for observation use once they became fully depleted. As stated in CIG's Petition to Amend Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Authorize the Continued Development of the Flank Storage Field ("Petition to Amend") filed August 14, 1984, CIG would file a report with the Commission listing those oil wells converted in the previous calendar year by May 31 of the following year. Accordingly, CIG is filing this report.

Description of Information Being Filed

Pursuant to Sections III and IV of the Petition to Amend and the Commission's Order, CIG is filing its calendar year 2018 oil well conversion report for the Flank Storage Field. During the January 1, 2018, through December 31, 2018 reporting period, no oil wells were converted to injection/withdrawal wells at its Flank Storage Field. In addition, CIG notes that it did not plug or abandon any oil wells during this time period.

Filing Information

CIG is e-Filing this report with the Commission's Secretary in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet*, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007 in Docket No. RM07-16-000.
