Acceptance of Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity

Dear Ms. Reese:

On December 18, 2024, the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") issued its "Order Issuing Certificate and Approving Abandonment" in the above-referenced dockets approving the authorizations requested jointly by Cheyenne Plains Gas Pipeline Company, L.L.C. ("Cheyenne Plains") and Natural Gas Pipeline Company of America LLC ("Natural") pursuant to sections 7(b) and 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act² and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations.³ As relevant here, the Commission granted Cheyenne Plains a certificate of public convenience and necessity ("Certificate") to acquire by lease 75,000 dekatherms per day ("Dth/d") of unsubscribed capacity from Natural and use that capacity to offer service under Cheyenne Plains' Tariff.⁴ Therefore, in compliance with Section 157.20(a) of the Commission's regulations, 18 C.F.R. § 157.20(a) (2024), Cheyenne Plains hereby accepts the Certificate. Nothing contained in this acceptance is intended to preclude or eliminate Cheyenne Plains right to request clarification and/or rehearing of certain portions of the Order within the timeframe allowed under the Commission's regulations.

This filing is being filed with the Commission's Secretary in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet*, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007, in Docket No. RM07-16-000.


