### Commissioners:

El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. ("EPNG") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP20-483-000, its weekly status report related to the Carlsbad South Project ("Project").

## **Description of Proceeding**

On June 19, 2020, EPNG filed a prior notice request pursuant to Sections 157.205, 157.208(b), and 157.210 of the Commission's regulations under the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct an approximate 17.1-mile sixteen-inch (16") outside diameter ("O.D.") loop line of its existing sixteen-inch (16") O.D. Line No. 3191 in Eddy County, New Mexico as well as to undertake minor appurtenant facility modifications at an existing compressor station at Lea County, New Mexico. This project is referred to as the Carlsbad South Project. At the conclusion of the notice period for the Carlsbad South Project on August 24, 2020, the project was deemed approved.

## **Submittal of Status Report**

In compliance with Section 157.208(c)(10) of the Natural Gas Act, EPNG is providing Environmental Inspector Report No. 20 for the period of January 4, 2021 through January 10, 2021.



One problem area identified during this reporting period. Air compressor and dryer unit secondary containment was not cleaned out in a timely manner. Lead environmental inspector identified the problem area and notified the contractor. The contractor cleaned out the secondary containments and transported material to sealed drums located within the laydown yard. Material will be disposed of in accordance with the Project's Waste Management Plan.

No environmental compliance issues/resolutions occurred during this reporting period.


