### Commissioners:

El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. ("EPNG") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP20-483-000, its weekly status report related to the Carlsbad South Project ("Project").

## **Description of Proceeding**

On June 19, 2020, EPNG filed a prior notice request pursuant to Sections 157.205, 157.208(b), and 157.210 of the Commission's regulations under the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct an approximate 17.1-mile sixteen-inch (16") outside diameter ("O.D.") loop line of its existing sixteen-inch (16") O.D. Line No. 3191 in Eddy County, New Mexico as well as to undertake minor appurtenant facility modifications at an existing compressor station at Lea County, New Mexico. This project is referred to as the Carlsbad South Project. At the conclusion of the notice period for the Carlsbad South Project on August 24, 2020, the project was deemed approved.

## **Submittal of Status Report**

In compliance with Section 157.208(c)(10) of the Natural Gas Act, EPNG is providing Environmental Inspector Report No. 24 for the period of February 1, 2021 through February 7, 2021.

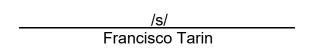

#### 1. SUMMARY OF CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY FOR INSPECTION PERIOD:

#### Line No. 31113:

- Restoration is largely complete.
- Removal of erosion control devices following the installation of permanent BMPs completed.
- Frac-tanks and construction materials continued to be removed from Project.
- Water truck operations continue on ROW and access roads, as needed for remaining work.

### 2. RELEVANT ENVIRONMENTAL ACTIVITIES:

During this reporting period four (4) additional staff received environmental training. In total seven hundred seventy (770) individuals received training.

#### 3. ENVIRONMENTAL PROBLEMS/ISSUES AND CORRECTIVE ACTIONS TAKEN:

Heavy equipment operations were suspended on several days due to high winds generating dust. Work commenced after high winds subsided.

#### 4. ENVIRONMENTAL COMPLIANCE ISSUES/RESOLUTIONS:

No environmental compliance issues or resolutions occurred during this reporting period.

### 5. ISSUES AND CONCERNS IDENTIFIED BY LANDOWNERS:

No landowner issues or concerns identified during this reporting period.

#### 6. WORK PLANNED FOR THE FOLLOWING REPORTING PERIOD:

Clean up and restoration will continue. Frac-tanks will continue to be removed from the area. Crews will complete installing cathodic protection, sub-mar mats, and fencing. Access roads no longer needed for Project construction will be regraded/restored.
