El Paso Natural Gas Company, L.L.C. ("EPNG") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP26-156-000; its weekly construction status report related to EPNG's Permian West Expansion Project ("Project").

Description of Proceeding

On March 27, 2026, EPNG submitted a Request for Prior Notice Authorization Pursuant to Blanket Certificate in the above-referenced docket seeking authorization to construct, install, operate and maintain an approximately nine-mile, 30-inch outside diameter pipeline loop extension and related appurtenances, located in Hudspeth County, Texas as part of its Project.¹ The Project is designed to provide additional firm transportation capacity on EPNG's Line No. 1100 system.

Submittal of Status Report

In compliance with Section 157.208(c)(10) of the NGA, EPNG is providing its Environmental Inspector Report No. 3.

The environmental inspector conducted stormwater pollution prevention-related inspections and inspected all work areas each day for the presence of sensitive species.
