## COMPREHENSIVE PRIVACY NOTICE FOR CLIENTS, COUNTERPARTIES AND LANDOWNERS

### I. Identity of the Data Controller.

KMGNM, with address at Avenida Ejército Nacional No. 843-B, Antara B1 U Priv. Ofic. Gm, 7th Floor, Colonia Granada, C.P. 11520, Miguel Hidalgo Borough, Mexico City, Mexico, is responsible for the processing of personal data of clients, commercial counterparties, landowners, legal representatives, and third parties related to projects, contracts, permits, rights of way, and easements.

Personal data is processed in alignment with Kinder Morgan group corporate privacy policies, to the extent they are compatible with and do not contravene applicable Mexican law.

### II. Personal Data Processed.

Personal data processed by KMGNM includes, without limitation:

- **Identification and contact data:** name, company name, address, telephone number, email address, signature, official identification.
- **Contractual and commercial relationship data:** contracts, agreements, powers of attorney, legal representative information, and supporting documentation.
- **Land and real property documentation:** cadastral information, deeds, lease agreements, easements, rights of way, permits, authorizations, and regulatory filings with competent authorities.
- **Financial and banking data:** information necessary for payments, invoicing, and tax compliance.
- **Records and communications:** electronic communications, meeting minutes, reports, and documentation related to projects and regulatory compliance.

Where sensitive personal data is collected on an exceptional basis, it will be processed only when strictly necessary and with the data subject's express consent, in accordance with applicable law.

### III. Purposes of Processing.

**Primary purposes:**

- (i) Management, negotiation, execution, and administration of commercial and contractual relationships;
- (ii) Compliance with legal and regulatory obligations applicable to the energy, environmental, administrative, and tax sectors;
- (iii) Management of permits, authorizations, rights of way, easements, and infrastructure projects;
- (iv) Prevention, handling, and follow-up of operational, legal, or regulatory contingencies;
- (v) Attention to internal, external, corporate, or regulatory audits.

**IV. Personal Data Transfers.**

Personal data may be transferred, without requiring additional consent, to:

- Competent governmental authorities, including, by way of example, CNE, ASEA, SEMARNAT, and local or federal authorities, when required to comply with legal or regulatory obligations;
- Judicial or administrative authorities, in connection with proceedings, disputes, or formal requests;
- Kinder Morgan corporate entities, including those located abroad, exclusively for corporate reporting, audit, regulatory compliance, and internal control purposes;
- External advisors, such as notaries public, auditors, technical or legal consultants, when necessary for the proper execution of projects or contracts.

All transfers are carried out in accordance with applicable law and under reasonable security measures.

**V. ARCO Rights and Revocation of Consent.**

Data subjects may exercise their rights of Access, Rectification, Cancellation, or Opposition (ARCO), as well as revoke consent, by submitting a request to:
