COMPREHENSIVE PRIVACY NOTICE FOR VISITORS TO FACILITIES

Kinder Morgan Gas Natural de México, S. de R.L. de C.V. (“KMGMN”)

I. Identity of the Data Controller.

KMGMN, with address at Avenida Ejército Nacional No. 843-B, Antara B1 U Priv. Ofic. Gm, 7th Floor, Colonia Granada, C.P. 11520, Miguel Hidalgo Borough, Mexico City, Mexico, is responsible for the processing of personal data of individuals who enter its facilities as visitors, suppliers, contractors, auditors, authorities, or any other authorized third party.

Personal data is processed in accordance with Kinder Morgan group corporate privacy policies, to the extent they are compatible with and do not contravene applicable Mexican law.

II. Personal Data Collected.

For the purposes described herein, KMGMN may collect the following personal data:

- **Identification and contact data:** full name, company of origin, official identification, signature.
- **Access records:** date and time of entry and exit, areas visited.
- **Images and video recordings:** photographs and video surveillance systems (CCTV) in common and access areas.
- **Industrial safety protocol data:** information necessary for risk prevention, emergency control, and regulatory compliance.

In exceptional cases where sensitive personal data is collected, such data will be processed only when strictly necessary and with the data subject's express consent, in accordance with applicable law.

III. Purposes of Processing.

Primary purposes:

- (i) Control and registration of access to operational and administrative facilities;
- (ii) Ensuring the physical and industrial security of individuals, facilities, and assets;
- (iii) Prevention of incidents, accidents, and risk situations;
- (iv) Compliance with legal and regulatory obligations applicable to energy-sector facilities;

(v) Handling internal, corporate, or regulatory audits, as well as investigations arising from incidents.

IV. Personal Data Transfers.

Personal data may be transferred, without requiring additional consent, to:

- Competent authorities, when required for compliance with legal or regulatory obligations or as a result of security incidents;
- Kinder Morgan corporate entities, including abroad, exclusively for audit, corporate compliance, internal control, and risk management purposes.

All transfers will be carried out in accordance with applicable law and under reasonable security measures.

V. ARCO Rights and Revocation of Consent.

Data subjects may exercise their rights of Access, Rectification, Cancellation, or Opposition (ARCO), as well as revoke consent, by submitting a request to:

VI. Security Measures.

KMGNM has implemented reasonable administrative, physical, and technical security measures to protect personal data against damage, loss, alteration, destruction, or unauthorized use, access, or processing.

This Privacy Notice constitutes the governing document for personal data protection in KMGNM's operations in Mexico, without prejudice to the application of internal corporate policies, to the extent they are compatible with Mexican law.
