Mojave Pipeline Company, L.L.C. ("Mojave") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP21-495-000, its weekly status report related to the Oak Creek Delivery Point Project ("Project").

### **Description of Proceeding**

On September 13, 2021, Mojave filed a prior notice request pursuant to Sections 157.203, 157.205, and 157.211 of the Commission's regulations under the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct the Oak Creek Delivery Point located in Kern County, California. On September 23, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Request Under Blanket Authorization initiating the 60 day comment period to allow for any person or Commission's staff to file motions or notice to intervene and protests. Since no protests were filed within the comment period, the Project was deemed to be authorized on November 23, 2021.

### **Submittal of Status Report**

Mojave is herein providing Environmental Inspector Report No. 16 for the period of January 15, 2023 through January 21, 2023.

### **Filing Information**

<p><b>1. Summary of Construction Activity for Inspection Period:</b> Michels Pipeline, Inc. ("Michels"), Mojave and CalPortland's construction contractor conducted hydrostatic testing, cleaning and drying of the non-jurisdictional lateral between CalPortland's new meter station and the Mojave Oak Creek Delivery tap. In addition, Michels worked on pipe supports at the Mojave Oak Creek Delivery tap site and began clean-up activities of the areas around the new meter and the tap site.</p> <p><b>2. Relevant Environmental Activities:</b> There were no environmental activities or training that took place during this reporting period.</p> <p><b>3. Environmental Problems/Issues and Corrective Actions Taken:</b> There were no environmental problems or issues identified during this reporting period.</p> <p><b>4. Environmental Compliance Issues/Resolutions:</b> There were no environmental compliance issues identified during this reporting period.</p> <p><b>5. Issues and Concerns Identified by Landowners:</b> There were no landowner issues or concerns were reported during this reporting period.</p> <p><b>6. Work Planned for the Following Reporting Period:</b> During the next reporting period, it is anticipated that Michels will complete sandblasting and painting of the pipe supports at the Mojave Oak Creek Delivery tap site. Even though minor clean-up and final site close-out activities are pending at the tap site, Mojave anticipates the Oak Creek Delivery tap being mechanically complete and ready for service during the next reporting period.</p> <p>With regard to the CalPortland meter station, Michels will (i)conduct clean-up activities; (ii) schedule Kern County-required inspections of sonotubes and rebar installation; (iii) complete remaining concrete work; and (iv) set the new meter and flow control mechanism.</p>
