Mojave Pipeline Company, L.L.C. ("Mojave") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP21-495-000, its weekly status report related to the Oak Creek Delivery Point Project ("Project").

Description of Proceeding

On September 13, 2021, Mojave filed a prior notice request pursuant to Sections 157.203, 157.205, and 157.211 of the Commission's regulations under the Natural Gas Act for authorization to construct the Oak Creek Delivery Point located in Kern County, California. On September 23, 2021, the Commission issued a Notice of Request Under Blanket Authorization initiating the 60 day comment period to allow for any person or Commission's staff to file motions or notice to intervene and protests. Since no protests were filed within the comment period, the Project was deemed to be authorized on November 23, 2021.

Submittal of Status Report

Mojave is herein providing Environmental Inspector Report No. 11 for the period of December 11, 2022 through December 17, 2022.

<p>1. Summary of Construction Activity for Inspection Period: Michels Pipeline, Inc. ("Michels"), Mojave and CalPortland's construction contractor undertook the following activities: (i) installed five sonotubes for support of the 6-inch offset section going from the flow control mechanism at the new CalPortland meter station site to the pipeline; (ii) installed rebar cages in the installed sonotubes in preparation for concrete pouring; (iii) replaced two damaged sonotubes; (iv) set in position the new CalPortland meter next to the flow control mechanism; and (v) installed a six-inch offset section to the pipeline and flow control mechanism for pipeline testing at the new CalPortland meter station site.</p> <p>2. Relevant Environmental Activities: There were no environmental activities or training that took place during this reporting period.</p> <p>3. Environmental Problems/Issues and Corrective Actions Taken: There were no environmental problems or issues identified during this reporting period.</p> <p>4. Environmental Compliance Issues/Resolutions: There were no environmental compliance issues identified during this reporting period.</p> <p>5. Issues and Concerns Identified by Landowners: There were no landowner issues or concerns were reported during this reporting period.</p> <p>6. Work Planned for the Following Reporting Period: Michels anticipates that it will begin testing the lateral pipeline and arrange for concrete to be poured. Construction activities will be suspended for the Christmas holiday from Thursday, 12/22/22 to Tuesday, 12/27/22.</p>
