Quarterly Post-Construction Status Report

Dear Secretary Bose:

Mojave Pipeline Company, L.L.C. is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP14-129-000 its Quarterly Post-Construction Status Report related to the Mojave Line No. 1901 Replacement Project ("Project").

Description of Proceeding

On March 31, 2014, Mojave filed an application, pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act, requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity to replace certain pipeline facilities in Kern County, California.¹ The Commission approved the Application on July 17, 2014. Mojave commenced service on the Line No. 1901 Replacement Project facilities on January 26, 2015.

Submittal of Status Report

Mojave is herein providing a quarterly post-construction status report for the period of October 1, 2018 through December 31, 2018.

¹ In light of the fact that the Project involved replacement of jointly-owned common pipeline facilities, Mojave Pipeline Company, L.L.C. and Kern River Gas Transmission Company filed a joint certificate application to secure the necessary authorizations.

Mojave is efiling this letter with the Commission's Secretary in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet*, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007 in Docket No. RM07-16-000. Quarterly Report Milestones:

During this reporting period, Mojave contracted Rocky Mountain Reclamation to remove existing weeds and reseed Segment 1 (between State Highway 119 and Harrison Street) pursuant to a letter dated September 26, 2018 from the Bakersfield Field Office for Bureau of Land Management ("BLM") addressing revegetation success along the ROW of Mojave's Line No. 1901 Replacement Project. As noted in its last quarterly report, the BLM requested that Mojave reseed this area. Mojave reseeded this portion of Segment 1 on December 17, 2018.

As referenced in previous reports, Segment 2 has not been reseeded in accordance with the private landowner's request.

Kinder Morgan and Kern River Gas continue to move forward with having the Center for Natural Lands Management ("CNLM") take fee title and management of the Petit Property while the California Department of Fish and Wildlife ("CDFW") will hold the Conservation Easement. As previously reported, this process is in the final stages of completing the Agreement for Ownership, Stewardship, and Endowment Management with CNLM. The Companies have submitted all required documents to the CDFW and are awaiting final approval.

Landowner Complaints:

There was no landowner/resident complaints received during this reporting period.




Photo No. 5: Line 1901 Replacement Project, Kern County, California

Comments: Photo taken looking southeast toward I-119. Reseeding complete.




Photo No. 6: Line 1901 Replacement Project, Kern County, California


Location: Segment 1, west of I-119.
