Sierrita Gas Pipeline LLC ("Sierrita") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP18-37-000, its biweekly status report related to the Sierrita Compressor Expansion Project.

Description of Proceeding

On December 21, 2017, Sierrita submitted its application, pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for authorization to construct, install, and operate a new compressor ("Sierrita Compressor Station") to be located in Pima County, Arizona. The project is referred to as the "Sierrita Compressor Expansion Project."

Submittal of Status Report

In compliance with Environmental Condition No. 8 of Appendix A to the Order, Sierrita is providing Project Status Report No. 3 for the period of May 5, 2019 through May 18, 2019.

1. Summary of Construction Activity for Inspection Period:

During this reporting period, the contractor finished backfilling the ditch. Restoration activities included grading and smoothing the ground surface back to original contours and elevations. The contractor performed cleanup operations. Fence crew mobilized to begin to re-install the chain link security fence. Pole installation was completed.

2. Relevant Environmental Activities:

During this reporting period, no one received environmental training. A total of twenty-five (25) people have received environmental training on the Sierrita Compressor Expansion Station Project.

The contractor has been using water trucks for dust control.

3. Environmental Problems/Issues and Corrective Actions Taken:

There were no environmental problems or issues identified during this reporting period.

4. Environmental Compliance Issues/Resolutions:

There were no other environmental compliance issues identified during this reporting period.

5. Issues and Concerns Identified by Landowners:

No landowner issues or concerns were identified during this reporting period.

6. Work Planned for the Following Reporting Period:

It is anticipated during the next reporting period the construction contractor will complete the fence installation. Restoration of the disturbed areas will be completed with seeding. The original seed mix developed for the Line No. 2177 installation project will be used.


