Sierrita Gas Pipeline LLC ("Sierrita") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP18-37-000, its quarterly post-construction status report related to the Sierrita Compressor Expansion Project.

Description of Proceeding

On December 21, 2017, Sierrita submitted its application, pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for authorization to construct, install, and operate a new compressor ("Sierrita Compressor Station") to be located in Pima County, Arizona. The project is referred to as the "Sierrita Compressor Expansion Project."

Submittal of Status Report

Consistent with the Project's Upland Erosion Control, Revegetation, and Maintenance Plan reporting requirements, Sierrita is herein filing a quarterly status report describing its post-construction maintenance/reclamation efforts for the period of October 1, 2021 to December 31, 2021.

Filing Information

Sierrita is e-Filing this letter and report with the Commission's Secretary in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet*, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007 in Docket No. RM07-16-000.



Activities During the Reporting Period

Sierrita worked with the City of Tucson Water Department on conducting a post-construction water test for the water well located within 100 feet of the construction area. The City of Tucson Water Department collected the water sample and performed the testing on October 29, 2020. On December 16, 2020, the City of Tucson Water Quality Lab reported to Sierrita that their testing demonstrated that no irregularities were present in the water samples that were collected on October 29, 2020. These results confirm that Sierrita's compressor station construction activities did not affect the water well.

No restoration activities were conducted during the reporting period.

No weed control activities were conducted during the reporting period.
