Dear Ms. Reese:

On September 3, 2026, Wyoming Interstate Company, L.L.C. ("WIC") and Fort Union Gas Gathering, L.L.C. ("FUGG") received a data request ("Data Request") from the Office of Energy Projects ("OEP") seeking information pertaining to the proposed WIC-FUGG Capacity Lease Project. WIC and FUGG are herein filing its response with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission").

Description of Proceeding

On June 23, 2026, WIC and FUGG filed a joint application pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act and Part 157 of the Commission's regulations requesting authorization for WIC to lease 50,000 dekatherms per day of natural gas transportation capacity, from a new receipt point on FUGG's system located in Campbell County, Wyoming, to an existing interconnection between FUGG and WIC in Converse County, Wyoming. In addition, FUGG is requesting a limited jurisdiction certificate to allow for the transportation of interstate natural gas through its respective system, while leaving its natural gas gathering system exempt from NGA jurisdiction. The project is referred to as the WIC-FUGG Capacity Lease Project.

Description of Information Being Filing

WIC is herein submitting its response to the Data Request.

Filing Information

WIC is e-Filing this letter and its response with the Commission's Secretary in accordance with the Commission's Order No. 703, *Filing Via the Internet*, guidelines issued on November 15, 2007 in Docket No. RM07-16-000.

The application states that Fort Union will need to construct a 2,100 foot 24-inch diameter lateral pipeline and a new meter station to transport the lease capacity to be provided by WIC to ONEOK Rockies Midstream LLC, through the use of Fort Union's system capacity. Clarify whether the lateral will be used as part of Fort Union's gathering system in addition to transporting the lease capacity associated with the FUGG Capacity Lease Project.

Response:

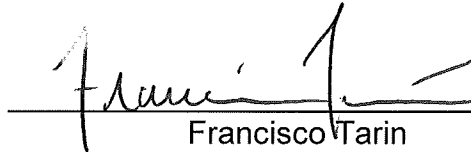
The 2,100 foot lateral to be constructed by FUGG will be owned and operated as part of the FUGG system; however, all of the capacity on the lateral will be leased to WIC such that the lateral is not going to be used in gathering service as part of FUGG's gathering system.

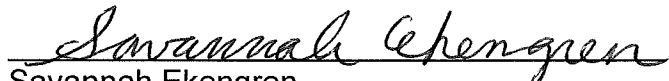

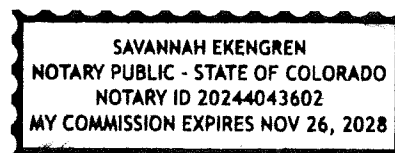
