Commissioners:

Wyoming Interstate Company, L.L.C. ("WIC") hereby tenders for filing and acceptance by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") the following tariff records for inclusion in Part II of WIC's FERC Gas Tariff, Third Revised Volume No. 2 ("Tariff"):

Section 4.2 Koch Energy Services, LLC #221915-ROLWIC Version 6.0.0 Section 4.3 Land's End Energy, LLC #221920-ROLWIC Version 6.0.0 Section 4.4 Mieco LLC #221919-ROLWIC Version 3.0.0

Proposed with an effective date of January 1, 2026, these tariff records update WIC's Statement of Negotiated Rates in its Tariff to reflect three new negotiated rate agreements executed between WIC and Koch Energy Services, LLC ("Koch"), Land's End Energy, LLC ("Land's End"), and Mieco LLC ("Mieco") (collectively referred to herein as the "Shippers"). WIC respectfully requests a waiver of the 30-day notice requirement to permit the tariff records to become effective on the proposed date of January 1, 2026, consistent with the effective date of the agreements.

Reason for Filing

Section 4.15 of the General Terms and Conditions ("GT&C") of the Tariff allows WIC and a shipper to agree to a service rate under any rate schedule that varies as to the form of the rate and/or from the minimum-to-maximum range provided on the Statement of Rates. Recently, WIC and the Shippers entered into park and loan service request orders ("PAL ROs") under three existing interruptible parking and lending service agreements pursuant to Rate Schedule PAL.¹ These

A PAL RO evidences the parties' agreement on the terms including the rate of the particular transaction(s) to park and loan gas pursuant to the interruptible parking and lending agreement.

three new PAL ROs provide for WIC to lend gas to the shippers on an interruptible basis on WIC's mainline and are subject to the fixed negotiated initial rates shown in such agreements and reflected on the tariff records attached herewith.² Further, the PAL ROs include the service dates and maximum PAL quantities shown in the table below.

When implementing a negotiated rate agreement, the Commission's policy requires pipelines to file either the agreement or a Statement of Rates tariff record identifying the transaction.³ In accordance with this policy, WIC is submitting tariff records to reflect the terms of the Shippers' PAL ROs. These negotiated rate PAL ROs are similar to other negotiated rate PAL agreements accepted by the Commission.⁴

Description of Filing

WIC is submitting the following tariff records pursuant to 18 C.F.R. § 154.112(b) (2025) and Subpart C of Part 154 of the Commission's regulations.⁵

Part II, Sections 4.2 through 4.4 reflect the negotiated rates and terms applicable to the Shippers' PAL ROs. The proposed tariff records applicable to each shipper include its legal name, the negotiated rate, the PAL point, the maximum PAL quantity, the applicable Rate Schedule for the service, and the term of service. Additionally, consistent with the Commission's policy, WIC has included a statement on the proposed tariff records to note that the underlying agreement conforms in all material respects with WIC's Rate Schedule PAL pro forma service agreement.

Section 3.2(a) of Rate Schedule PAL of the Tariff describes the "Initial Rate" as a rate applicable for each dekatherm of gas tendered for park or taken for loan during the month.

Procedural Matters

In accordance with the applicable provisions of Part 154 of the Commission's regulations,⁶ WIC is submitting an eTariff XML filing package, which includes the following:

- a) a transmittal letter; and
- b) clean and marked versions of the tariff records in PDF format.

WIC respectfully requests the Commission accept the tendered tariff records for filing and permit them to become effective on January 1, 2026, contemporaneous with the effective dates of the PAL ROs. As such, WIC requests the Commission grant a waiver of the notice requirements as permitted by 18 C.F.R. § 154.207 (2025) of the Commission's regulations. With respect to any tariff record the Commission allows to go into effect without change, WIC hereby moves to place the tendered tariff record in to effect at the end of any minimal suspension period established by the Commission.






