Acceptance of Certificate Order Approving Capacity Increase

Commissioners:

Young Gas Storage Company, Ltd. ("Young") is hereby filing with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. CP19-115-000 its acceptance of the Order Issuing Certificate ("Order") dated June 6, 2019<sup>1</sup> in this proceeding.

### **Description of Proceeding**

On March 26, 2019, Young submitted its application, pursuant to Section 7(c) of the Natural Gas Act requesting a certificate of public convenience and necessity for authorization to increase the total certificated gas storage inventory at its existing storage field located in Morgan County, Colorado, by an additional 1 Bcf from the existing 9.95 Bcf up to 10.95 Bcf. Young seeks to inject 800 MMcf of additional base gas inventory into its storage field in order to enhance the deliverability characteristics of the storage field. On June 6, 2019, the Commission issued a certificate order approving Young's requested capacity increase.

### **Acceptance of Certificate**

In compliance with Section 157.20(a) of the Commission's Regulations, Young is filing its acceptance of the Order issued June 6, 2019. The acceptance of certificate is attached behind this letter.

### **Filing Information**
